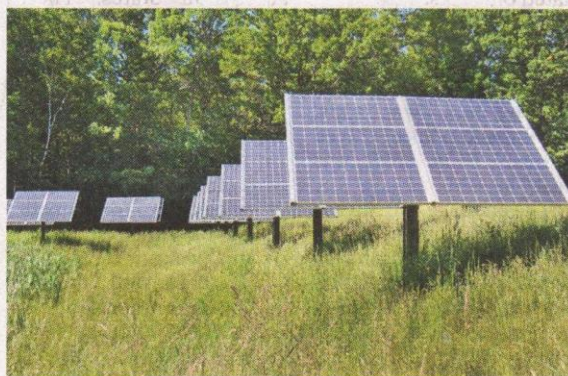
Fourth Partner Energy aims at Rs 300 cr revenue

It plans to achieve 1 GWp of distributed solar assets under management by 2022.
